I. ICO Meetings and venue

- 1. The Executive Director presents his compliments and wishes to inform ICO Members and observers about the 2nd World Coffee Conference from 23 to 25 September 2005, followed by the 94th Session of the International Coffee Council and other ICO meetings which will take place from 26 to 29 September.
- 2. The Conference and ICO meetings will all take place at the Pestana Bahia Hotel, Rua Fonte do Boi no. 216, Rio Vermelho, Salvador, Bahia, Brazil (Tel: +55 71 2103 8000, website: www.pestana.com).

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II. 2nd World Coffee Conference

- 3. Information about the 2^{nd} World Coffee Conference, including the preliminary programme, venue and other arrangements, has been circulated in ICC-93-6 and is available on the official Conference website (www.worldcoffeeconference.com). An updated programme will be circulated closer to the date of the Conference.
- 4. Each ICO Member country is entitled to **two** free places. Members are requested to consult the designated person for their country before registering for the free places, to avoid any overlap or duplication. For additional delegates or non-ICO members, the registration fee is US\$450 if registration is completed by 30 June 2005, or US\$550 thereafter.
- 5. Members are requested to inform representatives of the coffee sector in their country about the 2nd World Coffee Conference and to encourage their participation and contribution to this important event.

III. Registration

6. Delegates are requested to register as soon as possible.

8. Credentials should be sent to the Executive Director by **15 August 2005** as indicated in section X below.

IV. Hotel reservations

9. Delegates are responsible for booking their hotel accommodation, and can do this through the official travel agency Top Tours by 29 July 2005 preferably by registering online on the Conference website (www.worldcoffeeconference.com) or by faxing the attached hotel reservation form directly to the fax number shown on the form. A list of hotels and rates is attached as Annex I. Please note that there is considerable demand for hotel rooms in Salvador at this time of year and delegates are advised to make their reservations as early as possible.

V. Travel arrangements

- 10. Delegates are advised to make their travel arrangements as soon as possible, as flights to and from Brazil can get very full at this time of year. Travel arrangements can be made online on the Conference website or by contacting Top Tours (telephone: +55 (71) 2102 6622, fax: +55 (71) 2102 6633, email: tours@worldcoffeeconference.com).
- 11. There are direct international flights from Amsterdam, Lisbon, Madrid, Munich, Paris Tokyo, Vienna, and Zurich to the international airport in Salvador. The Pestana Bahia hotel is around 20 30 minutes by taxi or shuttle bus from the airport. The main international airports in Brazil are in São Paulo and Rio de Janeiro where participants can make flight connections to Salvador. Flights between São Paulo or Rio de Janeiro and Salvador take just under two and a half hours.

VI. Field visit to coffee-growing areas

- 12. Brazil has arranged a field visit to the coffee-growing areas in Bahia on Friday, 30 September 2005. The cost of the tour, which includes flights, is being subsidized by the State of Bahia and a fee of US\$200 is payable by delegates.
- 13. To reserve a place on the tour, please register online or fax the form (included in Annex III) no later than **29 July 2005** to the fax number shown on the form.

VII. Visas and passports

14. Delegates are advised to check with their authorities whether they require a visa for entry into Brazil. We understand that visas are <u>not</u> required by nationals of the following ICO Member countries:

Austria, Belgium, Bolivia, Colombia, Costa Rica, Denmark, Ecuador, Finland, France, Germany, Greece, Hungary, Ireland, Italy, Luxembourg, Netherlands, Norway, Paraguay, Philippines, Poland, Portugal, Slovenia, Spain, Sweden, Switzerland, Thailand, United Kingdom and Venezuela.

15. Passports must be valid for six months beyond the intended length of stay. Further information about visas and passport requirements can be obtained from the local Brazilian Embassy or Consulate, or websites such as www.brazil.org.uk.

Delegates are also requested to inform the Secretariat by the same date if they wish to make a presentation, so that the necessary arrangements can be made.
- 17. One team of interpreters will be available from 24 to 29 September 2005.

X. Credentials of Members

18. Members are reminded that Rule 3 of the *Rules of the Organization* (document EB-3820/02) requires them to inform the Executive Director, in writing, as soon as possible after receiving this communication, of the composition of their delegations. **Members are**

requested to ensure that their credentials reach the Organization no later than 15 August 2005 to facilitate preparation of the credentials report and List of Delegations in advance of the meetings.

- 19. Credentials should be issued in writing by a relevant Ministry or government agency of that country or by a representative of the Diplomatic Mission of the Member concerned either in the country where the seat of the Organization is located or where a session takes place. Faxed credentials may be accepted; however, Members are requested to provide original credentials after the session for record purposes.
- 20. The credentials of delegations will be examined by the Chairman, with the assistance of the Secretariat, who will report to the Council. The List of Delegations will be based on credentials received from Members and responses received from observers.

Observers – notification of attendance

21. Observers invited from non-member countries, international organizations and private sector associations wishing to attend the Council Session and/or other ICO meetings are requested to inform the Executive Director by **15 August 2005** of the specific meetings they wish to attend.

Badges

22. For the purposes of identification and security all participants attending the meetings are required to register on arrival at the Registration desk, and to wear the badges issued to them during all meetings listed above.

Health requirements for

entry into Brazil

Compulsory vaccinations:

Yellow fever certificate if arriving, within 3 months, from or in transit through the following countries: Angola, Benin, Bolivia, Burundi, Cameroon, Central African Rep., Colombia, Congo (both), Côte d'Ivoire, Ecuador, Ethiopia, Gabon, Ghana, Guinea, Kenya, Nigeria, Peru, Rwanda, Tanzania, Togo, Trinidad & Tobago, Uganda and Venezuela.

Recommended immunisations:

Diphteria, hepatitis A and B, malaria, polio, TB, tetanus and typhoid. Yellow fever is also recommended for travellers to rural areas. Please note that yellow fever vaccinations take approximately 10 days to become effective.

If there is any doubt about the need for vaccinations, please contact the local Consulate General or Embassy of Brazil.
