KARNATAKA GROWERS' FEDERATION National seminar on 'Coffee challenges and opportunities'

India produces one of the finest eco-friendly coffee in the world. The cultural operations in the estate being eco-friendly in nature, almost all works in the estate being done manually and hence it is labour intensive. The recent emergence of labour crisis and its impact on coffee production and management is enormous.

It is imperative to do -in depth analysis, the reasons for emergence of labour crisis and find the required suitable solutions. Future of coffee plantations lies mainly in equipping growers and workers, to adjust and modernise in response to prevailing conditions brought out by changing demands. Apart from this, work pattern of cultural operations in the estate need to be changed according to availability of workers.

In this situation growers can also think of diversification that helps in creating value additions to estates for sustainable economic growth.

Some of the challenges outlined above are complex and require considerable debate and careful thinking by all stakeholders. To facilitate evidence based discussion on critical prevailing and future issues, The Karnataka growers' Federation is organising a national seminar on "Coffee Challenges and opportunities'.

Conference themes

Theme 1: Emergence of labour crisis and management.

Specific issue would be social, economical and changing life style of workers. Some of the possible solutions to be discussed like introduction of mechanisation in plantations and saving of workforce/unit area without harming production.

Theme 2: Value additions to estates

Adoption of multi- income strategies for sustainable growth. It is in this context the major issues that would be addressed are:

- 1. Mapping of ecology to claim India's coffee as eco-friendly.
- 2.Eco Tourism
- 3. Bio fuel and carbon trading
- 4.Forest wealth
- 5. Micro hydro generators
