

## **5<sup>TH</sup> EDITION OF FESTICOFFEE**

The Cocoa and Coffee Inter-professional Council of Cameroon (CICC) invited the Acting Executive Director, Dr Denis Seudieu, to participate at the 5<sup>th</sup> Edition of FESTICOFFEE, a 'grand Public' Festival of African Coffee that took place in Yaoundé, Cameroon, from 20 to 22 April 2017. The Festival was opened by H.E. Mr Luc Magloire Mbarga Antangana, Minister of Commerce. The aim of the event was to promote the coffee industry in Africa. It was marked by the participation of VICOFA, the Coffee Sector authority of Vietnam.
