## Corrigendum

Decisions and Resolutions adopted at the 129<sup>th</sup> Session of the International Coffee Council

## Item 8.1: Finance and Administration Committee

Please add the following paragraphs:

- 65. The Chair of the FAC informed the Council on two paintings on display at the ICO headquarters. Although direct evidence of ownership did not exist, internal ICO documents demonstrated that the two paintings had been loaned by two Member countries, Brazil and Colombia. Since the ICO would very likely soon be moving to newer and smaller premises, the Secretariat had contacted the Brazilian and Colombian delegations. Both Members had requested the return of the works of art, while offering to pay for all costs associated with packaging, insurance and transportation.
- 66. The Committee recommended that the Council approve the return of the paintings to Brazil and Colombia.
  - 67. The Council approved the return of the paintings to Brazil and Colombia and instructed the Secretariat to inform Brazil and Colombia of such decision.
