Viet Nam**Pago de adeudos al presupuesto
administrativo**

DISTRIBUCIÓN LIMITADA

Antecedentes

1. Como se indicó en el documento relativo a la situación de contribuciones pendientes que afectan a los derechos de voto (documento [FA-351/23](#)), Viet Nam tiene una suma total de adeudos de £168.214 del año cafetero actual.

2. El Presidente de la Asociación del Café y el Cacao de Viet Nam (VICOFA) envió una carta con fecha de 24 de mayo de 2023 (véase el **ANEXO I**) en la que se propone el siguiente plan de cuotas para el pago de sus contribuciones pendientes por el año cafetero 2022/23:

- 1.ª cuota: un importe de 50 000 £ que se pagará en julio de 2023;
- 2.ª cuota: un importe de 25 000 £ que se pagará en septiembre de 2023;
- 3.ª cuota: un importe de 43 214 £ que se pagará en diciembre de 2023; y
- 4.ª cuota: un importe de 50 000 £ que se pagará en marzo de 2024.

Medidas que se solicitan

Se pide al Comité que examine si esta propuesta es aceptable como manera de liquidar los adeudos de Viet Nam y que formule una recomendación al Consejo relativa al mantenimiento de sus derechos de voto y otros derechos relacionados, en vista del esfuerzo que está realizando el país para abonar sus contribuciones pendientes.

VVICOFA highly appreciates the efforts of the ICO in the past time with the specific strategic goals of the ICO to help the global coffee industry develop in the context of the economic and financial difficulties in many countries due to the influence of the Covid-19 epidemic and international conflicts.

VICOFA is very grateful for the appreciation of the ICO with Vietnam's membership in the ICO Organization and wishes to contribute to the ICO Organization's activities to bring about sustainable development to the global coffee industry in general and the Vietnamese coffee industry in particular.

Following the letter of the Finance and Administration Committee ref. ACC/209 dated on 20 April 2023 acknowledged to receive the contribution of Vietnam to the Administrative Budget of ICO for the financial year 2021/2022, Vietnam is no longer in arrear for the Coffee Year 2021/22. Currently, the total amount due by Vietnam in relation to contributions to the Administrative Budget of the Organization is £168,214 for the financial year 2022/23.

For this amount, VICOFA, as a designated organization by the Ministry of Agriculture and Rural Development of Vietnam to contribute to the Administrative Budget of ICO, proposes the installment payment as follows:

1st Installment: an amount of £50,000 will be paid by July 2023

2nd Installment: an amount of £25,000 will be paid by September 2023

3rd Installment: an amount of £43,214 will be paid by December 2023

4th Installment: the remaining balance of £50,000 will be paid by March 2024

In case that VICOFA can collect the coffee export fee well, we will make our contribution to the administrative budget of ICO as soon as possible.

We look forward to receiving the sharing of the FAC and the International Coffee Council (ICC) to consider approving, maintaining voting rights and other related membership rights of Vietnam.
