Vietnam**Païement des arriérés de
contributions au budget administratif**

DISTRIBUTION RESTREINTE

Contexte

1. Comme indiqué dans le document concernant les arriérés de contributions affectant les droits de vote (document [FA-351/23](#)), le Vietnam a un total d'arriérés de £168 214 pour l'année caféière en cours.

2. Le Président de l'Association vietnamienne du café et cacao a soumis une lettre datée du 24 mai 2023 (voir **ANNEXE I**) demandant à l'OIC d'examiner le plan de paiement échelonné suivant pour le paiement de ses arriérés pour l'année caféière 2022/23 :

- 1^{er} versement : un montant de 50 000 £ à verser en juillet 2023 ;
- 2^{ème} versement : un montant de 25 000 £ à payer en septembre 2023 ;
- 3^{ème} versement : un montant de 43 214 £ à payer d'ici décembre 2023 ; et
- 4^{ème} versement : un montant de 50 000 £ à payer d'ici mars 2024.

Action

Le Comité est invité à examiner si cette proposition est acceptable en tant que moyen de régler les arriérés du Vietnam, et à faire une recommandation au Conseil en ce qui concerne le maintien de ses droits de vote et autres droits connexes, compte tenu des efforts déployés par le pays pour rembourser lesdits arriérés.

VVICOFA highly appreciates the efforts of the ICO in the past time with the specific strategic goals of the ICO to help the global coffee industry develop in the context of the economic and financial difficulties in many countries due to the influence of the Covid-19 epidemic and international conflicts.

VICOFA is very grateful for the appreciation of the ICO with Vietnam's membership in the ICO Organization and wishes to contribute to the ICO Organization's activities to bring about sustainable development to the global coffee industry in general and the Vietnamese coffee industry in particular.

Following the letter of the Finance and Administration Committee ref. ACC/209 dated on 20 April 2023 acknowledged to receive the contribution of Vietnam to the Administrative Budget of ICO for the financial year 2021/2022, Vietnam is no longer in arrear for the Coffee Year 2021/22. Currently, the total amount due by Vietnam in relation to contributions to the Administrative Budget of the Organization is £168,214 for the financial year 2022/23.

For this amount, VICOFA, as a designated organization by the Ministry of Agriculture and Rural Development of Vietnam to contribute to the Administrative Budget of ICO, proposes the installment payment as follows:

1st Installment: an amount of £50,000 will be paid by July 2023

2nd Installment: an amount of £25,000 will be paid by September 2023

3rd Installment: an amount of £43,214 will be paid by December 2023

4th Installment: the remaining balance of £50,000 will be paid by March 2024

In case that VICOFA can collect the coffee export fee well, we will make our contribution to the administrative budget of ICO as soon as possible.

We look forward to receiving the sharing of the FAC and the International Coffee Council (ICC) to consider approving, maintaining voting rights and other related membership rights of Vietnam.
