

## ICO/CPPTF - Focus on EUDR: Analysis of Implications

- **Considering** that EUDR has the potential to have a significant effect on the trade of coffee,
- **Considering** that ICO's Coffee Public Private Task Force includes key actors from the production, trade, transformation and consumption of coffee,
- **Considering** that CPPTF Sherpas have expressed concerns about the lack of clarity on the modalities for implementation of EUDR in coffee,
- **Considering** the ICO and the CPPTF have been engaged in the last 2 years in providing knowledge and a forum for ICO members on the EUDR and for engaging with members and the EU and the European Commission.

The Sherpas, at the CPPTF 14<sup>th</sup> meeting, agreed by consensus to request the CPPTF to focus on the compliance of the EUDR in the next months until the regulation starts to be implemented.

## Proposed urgent activities on EUDR

The CPPTF will add the following ACTIONS to be conducted this year:

**ACTION 1:** To collect and collate all “key clarification questions” by ICO members to be shared with the EU requesting for informed answers to be share in a comprehensive report with ICO members.

### Main Activities

- 1) Create and disseminate survey to collect information about key clarifying questions from member countries and private sector regarding the implementation of EUDR;
- 2) Use the survey to collect information about existing initiatives that coffee sector is implementing to support farmers to comply with EUDR;
- 3) Actively follow up with member countries to collect and validate information (direct contacts/calls);
- 4) Validate, review and analysis of information (aggregating repeating questions; clarification; classification of topics...) and prepare a consolidated report;
- 5) Submit report to the EU requesting urgent response to the ICO members request for clarifications
- 6) Response from EU shared with member countries and private sector to define actions and identify needs for assistance for preparedness to EUDR.

**Duration:** (October-December 2023, depending on availability of fund, identification of team of experts to work with ICO staff, recruitment process...)

**Required Budget:**                    **£20,000**

**ACTION 2:** Technical Workstream 3 to focus 80% of its time on EUDR implementation by:

- 1) Making an inventory of systems and pilots (including information of costs, goals) in producing countries working on implementation of EUDR
- 2) Widening the existing exchange platform with producing countries to disseminate and discuss information and learnings from these pilots;
- 3) Carry out 3 webinars with producing countries

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**Total Required budget**                      **£20,000**

**Resources**

The current CPPTF work programme (see annex 1) is funded by both public sector donors (GIZ, EU, SECO, UNIDO) and by private sector donors, ie signatories of the London Declaration.

To carry out above actions, we estimate that it would require around **GBP 20,000**.

In order to allocate unspent balance of the CPPTF, as these funds are provided by the by private sector donors, ie signatories of the London Declaration, they have to be consulted to seek their approval.
