# ECONOMICS COMMITTEE COMPARISON OF COMPOSITIONS CONSIDERED

## A) Fixed system – The Committee is composed of a fixed number of exporting and importing Members, with all others participating as observers

### B) Open system – All Members participate in the Committee

### C) Core group - Nomination of a core group

Advantages	Disadvantages
<ul> <li>May be a compromise between the other two systems.</li> <li>May ensure a balance between importing/exporting Members.</li> <li>May ensure geographical representation of the different regions.</li> <li>Overall membership would be open to all countries.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Same as option (A) but formally all ICO Members would be members of the Committee.</li> <li>Members would still have to nominate Committee members through their respective spokespersons for the consideration and approval of the Council.</li> <li>Unclear distinction between the role and responsibilities of all members versus those of the core group</li> <li>In-depth discussions and reaching consensus may be difficult with broader participation if the distinction between the core group and other members in not clear</li> </ul>
