

The archaeological park of Copan was declared a World Cultural Heritage Site by UNESCO based on the following criteria, which express the site's outstanding universal value:

"Its citadel and imposing public plaza reflect the three main stages of the city's development before it was abandoned at the beginning of the 10th century," constituting a representative example of a type of architectural complex that illustrates several significant periods in the history of Mayan civilization.

"The Hieroglyphic Stairway, located on the façade of Structure 10L-26, which bears the longest known Mayan hieroglyphic inscription, is associated with Mayan events and beliefs, and is an artistic work of exceptional universal significance." The Copán Valley (ruins, rivers, and tributaries) was declared a World Heritage Site by UNESCO in 1980.

*Jeanette Kawas National Park is comprised mostly of marine and coastal wetlands, including one of the best-preserved mangrove ecosystems in northern Honduras. In 2021, Honduras expanded the park's area from 78,150 to 79,382.16 hectares. The National Park is representative of the Honduran Caribbean and serves as a refuge for a wide diversity of aquatic and terrestrial species. Four species of mangrove can be found here, including the red mangrove (*Rhizophora mangle*) and the white mangrove (*Laguncularia racemosa*). The park also provides habitat for endangered species such as the nassau grouper (*Epinephelus striatus*), the elkhorn coral reef (*Acropora palmata*), the West Indian manatee (*Trichechus manatus*), the American crocodile (*Crocodylus acutus*), and the leatherback sea turtle (*Dermochelys coriacea*). Among the main threats to the site, particularly the coral reefs, are deforestation, erosion, and pollution from garbage and chemical pollutants dumped into the wetland's marine area.*
