Basis for the distribution of votes among importing Members for coffee year 2010/11

- The Executive Director presents his compliments and wishes to remind Members that, 1. under the provisions of paragraph (5) of Article 13 of the International Coffee Agreement 2001, the distribution of votes is determined by the Council at the beginning of each coffee year.
- 2. In order to permit the Council to take a decision on the distribution of votes among importing Members for coffee year 2010/11 it is necessary, in accordance with the provisions of paragraph (4) of Article 13, to establish the average volume of their imports of coffee from all sources in the preceding four calendar years, that is from 2006 to 2009. The attached table has been prepared as far as possible on the basis of information received from importing Members up to 30 June 2010.
- 3. If no objections are made by the importing Members concerned, the figures contained in the attached table will be used as the basis for the determination of the votes of importing Members in coffee year 2010/11. It would be appreciated if importing Members could notify the Executive Director as soon as possible of any corrections to be made to the figures.
- 4. Information on the basis for the distribution of votes among exporting Members for coffee year 2010/11 is contained in document ED-2091/10.
