Diversification programme

1. The Executive Director presents his compliments and wishes to remind Members that, at the meetings held from 24 to 27 September 2002, the Board and Council reviewed progress on developing a diversification programme and requested him to prepare an analysis of areas under coffee cultivation, the amount of land which might be available for diversification and possible crops or products which could be developed.
