**Basis for the distribution of votes
among importing Members
for coffee year 2005/06**

Background

1. The Executive Director presents his compliments and wishes to remind Members that, under the provisions of paragraph (5) of Article 13 of the International Coffee Agreement 2001, the distribution of votes is determined by the Council at the beginning of each coffee year.
2. In order to permit the Council to take a decision on the distribution of votes among importing Members for coffee year 2005/06 it is necessary, in accordance with the provisions of paragraph (4) of Article 13, to establish the average volume of their imports of coffee from all sources in the preceding four calendar years, that is from 2001 to 2004. The table presented in this document has been prepared on the basis of information received from importing Members up to 15 September 2005.
3. Based on revisions received from Finland, Germany, Norway and the USA, the table contained in document ED-1963/05 has been brought up-to-date and the relevant changes are reflected in the table attached.
4. Information on the basis for the distribution of votes among exporting Members for coffee year 2005/06 is contained in document ED-1962/05 Rev. 1.

The Executive Board and the Council are requested to take note of this document.
