# ROBUSTA AFRICAN GROUP REPRESENTATION TO THE INTERNATIONAL COFFEE ORGANISATION (ICO) EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE

Robusta producing African countries present at ICO meetings in Salvador-Bahia, namely: Côte d'Ivoire, Angola, Togo, Ghana and Cameroon met on Tuesday 27 September 2005 with the aim of appointing the Robusta African Group within ICO Executive Committee.

During the consultation, it had been decided that the Robusta African Group would be represented by one of the Robusta producing African countries by rotation.

Côte d'Ivoire had been chosen to run the Coffee Year 2005/2006, considering its permanent representation in London and the renegotiation of the 2001 International Coffee Agreement that starts during the same Coffee Year.

For the forthcoming coffee years, the Robusta producing African countries will charge their representative.
