# Project Update

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#### **Current activities**

- Field trials are winding down, analysis underway
- Focus now is on final testing of parameters of interest, e.g.:
  - Defects and correlation with risk
  - I Fermentation vs. dry processing
  - I Processing practices in various countries
  - Storage and transportation risks
- Results will help ensure evidence-based decision-making and recommendations



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#### **Current activities**

- Socio-economic studies and market chain analyses in four countries
- Sensitization of Stakeholders Seminar 8<sup>th</sup> October, Guatemala
- Training of Trainers' courses:
  - 11-22 October, Guatemala 7 countries
  - I 18-22 November, India 1 country
- I 15-26 November, Côte d'Ivoire 12 countries
- Development of CD-ROM training tool and website



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## CD-ROM Training Tool / WWW page

- 'Reducing OTA in coffee' Website being developed in conjunction with training CD-ROM - complementary
- Focus of project has always been on prevention strategies rather than regulation
- Application of prevention strategies still the only available method at farm level to combat OTA
- Key legacy of project will be self-sufficiency in training by national authorities



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### **CD-ROM Training Tool**

- Project identified a key need for an adaptable, comprehensive training tool:
- "Good Hygiene Practices along the coffee chain"
- Type of material included:
  - Full text documentation (regulations, Codex etc)
  - I Presentations (in .PPT and Flash)
  - I Supporting texts on key issues
  - Selected bibliographies
  - I Photographs
  - I Terminology & glossary
- Both products to be released by end 2004



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
