**Imports of soluble coffee classified under  
specific Harmonized System codes  
Calendar years 1996 to 2004**

## Background

1. At the meeting of the Statistics Committee in May 2006, the Secretariat was requested to prepare a table showing imports of soluble coffee classified under two specific Harmonized System (HS) codes (210.112.92 and 210.112.98) from 1996 to 2004, for Norway, Switzerland and USA. This exercise would supplement the one presented in document WP-Statistics No. 99/06 which lists data for EU countries only, and would assist the Committee in analysing possible adjustments to be made to the soluble coffee imports series held in the Organization's databases.
2. It should be noted that in accordance with the Rules on Statistics contained in document EB-3830/02, importing Members are requested to provide information on total imports by month, by form of coffee and by origin, not by HS codes. Therefore, data presented in this document are based on information available from the Eurostat website.
3. The attached tables show data, for each calendar year from 1996 to 2004<sup>1</sup>, on total imports of preparations and concentrates containing coffee by each importing Member country under the HS codes in question. Table 1 also gives the total coffee content under these two classifications in each calendar year together with the percentage change in two consecutive years. Tables 2 and 3 show total imports of all soluble coffee by all importing Member countries (using ICO data) and the percentage of imports of preparations and concentrates in this total in each year. In addition, Table 3 shows ICO data for soluble imports "adjusted" to take into account only 10% of the volume of total imports of the preparations and concentrates, which is deemed to be the average coffee content in the products. A similar exercise can be carried out for the series on re-exports to all destinations on the recommendation of the Committee at this meeting.
4. It should be noted that, for the earlier years, data are not available for those countries that acceded to the EU in May 2004. In addition, prior to 1998 information for Luxembourg was included with Belgian trade data.

## Action

The Statistics Committee is requested to analyse the results presented in this document and to make the appropriate recommendations for action.
