Compliance with the provision of statistical data

**Coffee years 1994/95 to 2002/03 and from
October 2003 to July 2004**

Background

1. This document provides information on the compliance of Members with the Rules on Statistics – Statistical Reports (document EB-3830/02) approved by the Council in September 2002. However, the status of compliance during the period covered herein reflects the time limit set in the previous Rules contained in document EB-3510/94. In the case of exporting Members, it also gives their compliance with the Rules for the application of a system of Certificates of Origin contained in document EB-3775/01.

2. The information contained herein covers the life of the 1994 Agreement (coffee years 1994/95 to 2000/01) and the first 2 years and ten months of the 2001 Agreement (**coffee years 2001/02; 2002/03 and from October 2003 to July 2004**). It gives the requirements for the supply of statistical information with details of specific problems for each year in the respective Annexes.

3. Compliance by exporting Members in respect of the provision of timely statistics based on monthly reports and Certificates of Origin in calendar years 2000 to 2003 is given in Annex 10. Similarly, Annex 11 shows the compliance by importing Members in the same period. These Annexes include 6 exporting and 2 importing countries, respectively, which were Members under the 1983 Agreement and which continue to be included in the historical statistical series of the Organization. In addition, ED documents requesting supplementary information from Members have been issued. Annex 12 shows compliance from Members with these requests.

Action

The Statistics Committee is requested to examine the compliance status of each Member of the Organization, in order to make the appropriate recommendations to the Executive Board.

Statistics provided by exporting Members

- *Preliminary monthly exports (Annex 1)*

1. Exporting Members are requested to send to the Organization, not later than **30 days** after the close of each month, information on the total exports in the previous month. If final figures are not available, provisional figures or estimates may be provided (see paragraph 3 (a) of the Rules on Statistics – Statistical Reports, document EB-3830/02).

- *Monthly Reports on exports (Annex 2)*

2. Exporting Members are requested to send to the Organization, not later than **60 days** after the close of each month, information on the volume and value of exports by form of coffee and by country of destination for the month under report. The information should be based on the relevant Certificates of Origin issued to cover coffee shipped during that period under report and should comply with the format specified in Annex I-B of the Rules on Statistics – Statistical Reports, document EB-3830/02.

- *Certificates of Origin (Annex 3)*

3. Exporting Members are requested to transmit data in electronic files or to forward the first copy of each Certificate of Origin together with a copy of the relevant Bill of Lading to the Organization (see paragraph 5 of Rule 4 of the Rules on Statistics – System of Certificates of Origin, document EB-3775/01). It should be noted that since October 2001, 21 exporting Members, which together accounted for over 86.7% of total exports in the first 10 months of coffee year 2003/04, are sending data electronically. Of the 76,650 records entered in the 2003/04 Certificates of Origin database, 72,897 records – equivalent to 95.1% of the total – were transferred electronically whereas 3,753 records – equivalent to 4.9% – were actually keyed in. The matter of technical or financial assistance for the implementation of an efficient statistical system is still to be formalised between the Organization and institutions, which might be able to provide assistance in this area. In addition, any Member country that may encounter difficulties in implementing the Rules is welcome to contact the Organization to request assistance.

- *Monthly prices paid to growers (Annex 4)*

4. Exporting Members are requested to send to the Organization information on the average price actually received by growers for their produce or the minimum price, if any, guaranteed by the Government to the growers on a monthly basis (see paragraph 9 on page 4 of the Rules on Statistics – Statistical Reports, document EB-3830/02).

- *Annual data on opening stocks, production and internal consumption (Annex 5)*

5. Exporting Members are requested to send to the Organization quarterly estimates of production and domestic consumption for the current crop year and the following crop year and closing stocks for the year at the end of each crop year (see Annex I-A and paragraph 2 on page 5 of the Rules on Statistics – Statistical Reports, document EB-3830/02). Those exporting Members producing/exporting more than one type of coffee or using different processing methods (dry and wet) are requested to indicate, in percentage terms, the type and method of processing.

Statistics provided by importing Members

- *Monthly Reports on imports and re-exports (Annex 6)*

6. Importing Members are requested to send complete reports to the Organization by email or fax, not later than **60 days** after the close of each month, information on the volume and value of imports by form of coffee and by country of origin and on the volume and value of re-exports by form of coffee and by country of destination for the month under report (see Annexes II-A and II-B and pages 3 and 4 of the Rules on Statistics – Statistical Reports, document EB-3830/02).

- *Monthly retail prices (Annex 7)*

7. Importing Members are requested to send to the Organization information on the representative retail market prices for roasted and/or soluble coffee for the month under report (see paragraph 10 on page 4 of the Rules on Statistics – Statistical Reports, document EB-3830/02).

- *Information on roastings (Annex 8)*

8. Importing Members are requested to send to the Organization information on the amount of green coffee that has been roasted at the end of each calendar year, where available (see paragraph 3 (a) on page 5 of the Rules on Statistics – Statistical Reports, document EB-3830/02).

- *Information on inventories (Annex 9)*

9. Importing Members are requested to send to the Organization information on the stocks of green coffee held by importers and roasters, including stocks in free ports where such exist, on the last day of the calendar year, if this information is available (see paragraph 3 (b) on page 5 of the Rules on Statistics – Statistical Reports, document EB-3830/02).

- *Information on changes made on taxes and duties, laws and regulations of coffee exports and imports in the country (Annex 12)*

10. All Members are requested to send to the Organization information on changes or revisions in the current level of taxes and duties on coffee exports/imports, or to the laws and regulations of coffee exports/imports in the country (see paragraph 5 on page 2 of the Rules on Statistics – Statistical Reports, document EB-3830/02). Compliance with this specific item is covered in paragraph 14 below, as it was the purpose of document ED-1861/02 issued on 25 November 2002. The status of compliance by each Member is given in Annex 12.

Compliance with ICC Resolution number 420

11. Following the adoption of ICC Resolution number 420 by the Council in May 2004, the Executive Director issued document ED-1918/04 requesting exporting Members to comply with the provisions of the Resolution. As compliance with the provisions of the Resolution is voluntary, the information on quality received from exporting Members could be monitored for coffee shipments that took place from 1 June 2004. The status of this compliance by exporting Members is also given in Annex 12.

Summary tables and conclusions (Annexes 10 and 11)

12. Annex 10 shows that for 25 exporting Members compliance with the Organizations' statistical requirements is full and satisfactory. This represents 83.15% of average exports in calendar years 2000 to 2003. Exports for 6 non-member countries listed represent only 3.01% of total exports in the period. Similarly, Annex 11 shows full or satisfactory compliance by all 18 importing Members, equivalent to 100% of average annual imports in the period. It should be noted that statistical data for the USA are provided punctually, therefore, importers' compliance level remains at 100%.

13. There are 10 exporting Members that are failing to comply with their statistical obligations. This represents only 5.03% of the average exports in the period under consideration. In addition to these, a group of 10 exporting Members, together accounting for 8.80% of the exports in the period, also show a poor compliance performance. The matter on technical assistance offered to these countries is still under consideration with potential institutions, which might have the financial resources for the implementation of an efficient statistical system in these countries. Discussions will continue to be pursued with the representatives of the countries concerned until a satisfactory solution can be achieved.

Supplementary information requested through documents ED-1840/02; ED-1851/02; ED-1856/02; ED-1861/02; ED-1870/03; ED-1911/04 and ICC Resolution Number 420 (Annex 12)

14. With a view to obtaining some important data considered vital to the statistics of the Organization, specific documents have been issued requesting exporting Member countries to provide supplementary information not covered by the statistical rules. These documents are: ED-1840/02 (Quarterly crop distribution) and ED-1856/02 (Diversification programme). Two other documents have also been issued to remind Members of their obligation to comply with the Rules for the application of a system of Certificates of Origin (exporting Members only) – document EB-3775/01, and with the Rules on Statistics – Statistical reports – document EB-3830/02. They are, respectively, document ED-1851/02 – Expiry date of adjustment period and document ED-1861/02 – Compliance with the Rules on Statistics (all Members).

15. A document was also issued with the purpose of consolidating all this supplementary information urging Members to respond to the requests made in the documents mentioned in paragraph 14. It was circulated to all Members in December 2002 (document ED-1863/02). In addition, document ED-1870/03 was circulated in March 2003 requesting exporting Members, in particular, to inform the Executive Director of the measures being taken to comply with the provisions of ICC Resolution No. 407 in producing countries. A further document was issued in March 2004 (document ED-1911/04) requesting exporting Members to also inform the Executive Director the volume of coffee estimated to have been withdrawn as a result of the implementation of the Coffee-Quality Improvement Programme. In addition, following the adoption of ICC Resolution number 420 the Organization started to monitor compliance by exporting Members based on information received from Certificates of Origin. Annex 12 indicates the date or status of compliance of the reply received from exporting Members on these specific requests.

16. Importing Members are just required to reply to the request made in document ED-1861/02. To date, the following importing Members have replied: Austria, Belgium, Denmark, Cyprus, Germany, Greece, Ireland, Italy, Japan, Luxembourg, Netherlands, Norway, Spain, Sweden and Switzerland and United Kingdom have provided the information requested. Information is still awaited from Finland, France and Portugal.

17. The expansion of the European Community as from 1 May 2004 has automatically brought in nine new consuming countries to the membership of the Organization – as Cyprus had already acceded as a Member. The new Members have been contacted by the Organization with a view to providing statistical data in accordance with the Rules on

Statistics contained in document EB-3830/02. As at today, cooperation has been received from the Czech Republic, Estonia, Latvia, Lithuania, Slovakia and Slovenia. We have also contacted the E.C. representative as cooperation from Hungary and Poland was not forthcoming. No reply has yet been received from Malta. The Organization will endeavour to obtain complete historical data from the new E.C. Members to the extent possible, so that, our databases will contain the latest available comprehensive data.
